Top trends so far...

We're a third of the way in to the season now - and there are plenty of solid betting trends to cash-in on. This exclusive report lifts the lid on the 'top trends' from the season's stats so far – bets that are paying out most often on each team, in 83%, 92% and even 100% of games.

Including bets on:

Top Trends – Team by Team...

I've done all the hard work and gone through all the stats and results for you - here are Football Betting Data's top trends for every Premier League team this season.

Arsenal

- 100% of Arsenal home games have been Over 2.5 Goals, and 10 out of 11 games overall have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets – 91% .

- Arsenal have also won the Most Corners in all 5 home games, and in 82% of games overall. Bets on Arsenal -3 Corner Handicap have paid out in 4 out of 5 games at the Emirates Stadium.
- 7 out of 8 Arsenal wins have been by 2 goals or more – covering a -1.5 Asian Handicap at the bookies...
- And Arsenal were also winning at Half Time and Full Time in 7 of those 8 games.

Aston Villa

- An Aston Villa player has been shown the First Card in 67% of games so far (8 out of 12).
- Last season 74% of all Villa games went Over 10.5 Corners. That trend is continuing this season, with 67% of games paying out on Over 10.5 Corners bets and games averaging 11+ Total Corners.

Birmingham

- Birmingham have got the First Card in 6 out of 6 away games so far.
- Birmingham's away 'Corners margin' is -5.8 and they've been out-cornered by at least 4 corners in 100% of away games. Meaning bets on the home team with a -3 Corner Handicap would've paid out every time.
- The Half Time Score has been 0-0 in 7 of Birmingham's 12 games – more times than any other Premier League team. If you'd placed that bet in every Birmingham game so far (at odds of 6/4 and bigger) you'd have made a 50% profit overall.

Blackburn

- Over 2.5 Goals bets have paid out in 73% of Blackburn games (8 games out of 11).
- All 5 Blackburn away games have been Under 10.5 Corners.

Bolton

- Bets on Over 10.5 Corners have paid out in 8 of Bolton's 11 games so far – 73%

- Bolton have only won the Most Corners in 1 game so far this season – and in none of their home games.
- 73% of Bolton games have been Over 2.5 Goals. And Bolton are the only team in the Premier League to have not kept a 'clean sheet' so far this season – they've conceded at least 1 goal in all of their first 11 games.

Burnley

- 5 out of 6 Burnley home games have gone Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points (eg. 3 or less yellow cards).
- The average First Goal Time in Burnley games is 24 minutes at home and 23 minutes away. Bets on the Time of First Goal to be Before 28th Minute have paid out a winner in 75% of Burnley games.

Chelsea

The league leaders have a stack of solid trends that you can cash-in on.

- Chelsea have won 10 of their first 12 games. And they have a 100% home record – 6 out of 6 wins at Stamford Bridge.
- 83% of Chelsea games have gone Over 10.5 Corners – their games are averaging 13 Total Corners.
- Chelsea have also won the Most Corners in 83% of games – and on average per game they are winning 4 corners more than opponents.
- 75% of Chelsea games have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets, with games averaging 3.1 Total Goals.

Everton

- Everton have been pretty well behaved so far – they haven't got the Most Booking Points in any of their 6 home games, and on average the away team is getting 2 or more yellow cards than the Blues (eg. 20+ Points more).
- Everton Home Booking Points averages = 10.8 Points For and 36.7 Points Against.

Fulham

- Fulham have failed to win the Most Corners in 9 out of 11 games so far – and they haven't got the Most Corners in any of their 6 away games.

- Fulham away corner averages = 3.7 Corners For and 8.2 Corners Against.
- Bets on Fulham's opponent with a -1 Corner Handicap would've paid out a winner in 5 out of 6 away games.

Hull

- In 5 out of 6 away games, a Hull player has been shown the First Card.
- Bets on Over 10.5 Corners have paid out in 67% of Hull games so far – their games are averaging 12 Total Corners.

Liverpool

- Liverpool have won the Most Corners in 75% of games overall – and in 100% of home games.
- Liverpool Home Corner averages = 9.5 Corners For and 3.0 Corners Against.
- A Liverpool player has only been shown the First Card in 1 of their 11 games. And the Reds have only got the Most Booking Points in 2 games.

Man Utd

- Man Utd have won the Most Corners in 92% of all games – 11 times out of 12. And on average they are winning over 6 corners per game more than opponents.
- At Old Trafford, United have won the Most Corners in 6 out of 6 games.
- Bets on Man Utd with a -4 Corner Handicap would have paid out a winner in 75% of games so far.

Man City

- 91% of City games have gone Over 10.5 Corners – with an average of 12.7 Total Corners per game.
- Last season 73% of games at the City of Manchester Stadium went Over 10.5 Corners. So far in 2009/10 that bet has paid out in 5 out of 5 home games.
- Man City have drawn 5 out of 11 games this season – more Draws than any other team in Premier League.

Portsmouth

- 83% of Portsmouth games have paid out a winner on Over 10.5 Corners bets. Average Total Corners per game = 12.3.
- 67% of Portsmouth games have been Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points

Stoke

- A Stoke player has got the First Card in 100% of their away games so far – 6 times out of 6.
- Stoke have got the Most Booking Points in 5 out of 6 away games.
- Stoke away average Booking Points = 30.8 Points For and 6.7 Points Against.

Sunderland

- 75% of Sunderland games have paid out on bets on the Time of First Goal to be Before 28th Minute. The average First Goal Time in Sunderland games is just 18 minutes.
- 5 out of 6 Sunderland home games have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets. Games at the Stadium of Light are averaging 4.0 Total Goals per game.

Tottenham

- Bets on Over 2.5 Goals have paid out on in 10 out of 12 Spurs games – 83%. With an average of 3.3 Total Goals per game.
- Spurs have only got the Most Booking Points in 1 game out of 12 so far.
- Tottenham have won 4 games by a 2-1 score-line. That Correct Score bet has paid out more often than any other score-line on any other Premier League team so far this season...
- If you'd had a £1 bet on Tottenham to win 2-1 in every game so far at odds of 7/1 and bigger, you'd have staked £12 and returned £32 – a 167% profit.

West Ham

- 100% of West Ham home games have been Over 2.5 Goals (6 games out of 6). And games at Upton Park are averaging 3.7 Total Goals.
- 67% of West Ham games have gone Over 10.5 Corners – with games averaging 12 Total Corners.

Wigan

- Bets on Over 2.5 Goals have paid out a winner in 5 out of 6 Wigan away games. Their away games are averaging 3.4 Total Goals.

Wolves

- 75% of Wolves games have paid out on bets on the Time of First Goal to be Before 28th Minute.
- 75% of Wolves games have also gone Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points. Their games are averaging 26 Total Booking Points (eg. less than 3 yellow cards per game).

Top Scorers

Here are the Premier League's Top Scorers so far. Including the stats on how often the 3 most common 'Scorer' bets – Anytime Scorer, First Goalscorer and Last Goalscorer - have paid out on the leading players.

Player	Club	Goals (up to 20 th Nov).
Fernando Torres	(Liverpool)	10 goals
Didier Drogba	(Chelsea)	9
Darren Bent	(Sunderland)	8
Wayne Rooney	(Man Utd)	7
Louis Saha	(Everton)	7
Robin van Persie	(Arsenal)	7

5 players on 6 goals.

- Torres has scored 10 goals in 10 games. Bets on him in the Anytime Scorer market have paid out 7 times, he has been the First Goalscorer in 4 games and the Last Goalscorer in 1 game.
- Drogba has scored 9 goals in 12 games. Anytime Scorer bets have paid out in 8 of those 12 games. He has been the First Goalscorer in 2 games and scored the Last Goal on 4 occasions.

- Bent has scored 8 goals in 12 games. Bets on him to Score at Anytime have paid out a winner 7 times. He's been the First Goalscorer in 6 games, and the Last Goalscorer on 3 occasions.
