Premier League 2009/10

Top trends so far...

13th October 2009.

There's a fifth of the season gone – each team has played 7 or 8 games - and already some strong form is on show...

Here are our 'top trends' from the stats so far – bets that are paying out most often on each team.

Look out in particular for Chelsea, Tottenham and Wolves' 100% records...

Arsenal

100% of home games have been Over 2.5 Goals, and 6 out of 7 games overall have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets.

Aston Villa

4 out of 4 home games gone Under 2.5 Goals. Games at Villa Park are averaging 2.1 total goals.

Birmingham

Birmingham have got the First Card in all 4 of their away games so far.

Blackburn

Blackburn's 3 away games to date have all paid out on these 3 bets - Over 2.5 Goals, Under 11 Corners and Under 3.5 Cards / Under 35.5 Booking Points.

Bolton

85% of all games have gone Over 10.5 Corners so far (6 games out of 7).

Burnley

Bets on Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points have paid out in 7 out of 8 Burnley Premier League games.

Chelsea

The league leaders have a 100% record for Over 10.5 Corners games so far - 8 out of 8 games have had 11 or more corners.

Everton

In 71% of Everton games, there have been Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points.

Fulham

Have only won the Most Corners in one out of 7 games so far. On average, Fulham are conceding 2 corners more than they win. Bets on Fulham's opponents with a '-1 Corner Handicap' would've paid out in 71% of games.

Hull

In 4 out of 4 away games so far, a Hull player has been shown the First Card.

Liverpool

Bets on 'high' Goals and Corners have paid out in the majority of Liverpool games so far – 7 out of 8 games have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets. And the same amount – 87.5% - have also gone Over 10.5 Corners.

Man Utd

75% of games have had 11 or more Corners so far. That includes 4 out of 4 games at Old Trafford where bets on Over 10.5 Corners have paid out a winner.

Man City

City games are also seeing plenty of corner kicks. Bets on Over 10.5 Corners have paid out in 85% of all games – 6 times out of 7. City games are averaging a total of 12.7 corners per game.

Portsmouth

The 'obvious' stat here is Portsmouth's form – they've lost 7 games out of 8 and are bottom of the Premier League. It's also worth knowing 75% of Portsmouth games to date have gone Over 10.5 Corners and Under 3.5 Cards / Under 35.5 Booking Points.

Stoke

Bets on Under 2.5 Goals are paying out a winner in 75% of Stoke games right now – and games are averaging 2.0 total goals.

Sunderland

Sunderland games are averaging a high 3.6 goals per game so far, with bets on Over 2.5 Goals paying out in 75% of all games - and 100% at the Stadium of Light (4 out of 4). And a player to watch for Goalscorer bets – Darren Bent has scored in 6 out of 8 games, and has been the First Scorer on 5 occasions.

Tottenham

A perfect 100% record for Over 2.5 Goals games from Spurs – 8 games out of 8 – and an average of 3.9 total goals per game.

West Ham

71% of games have been Over 10.5 Corners so far. That includes 3 from 4 away games that have had at least 12 corners.

Wigan

Wigan have only won the Most Corners once in 8 attempts (12.5%). On average, they are conceding 2 corners per game more than they win. And they haven't won the most corners in any of their 4 games at the DW Stadium.

Wolves

Check out this 100% trend – 8 out of 8 Wolves games have paid out on Time of First Goal 'Before 27th Minute' bets. And their average First Goal Time figure is just 14 minutes – the lowest in the Premier League.
