Premier League 2009/10

Top trends so far...

27th October 2009.

We're 10 games in to the season now - and some solid betting trends are starting to show. Here are our 'top trends' from the stats so far – bets that are paying out most often on each team, in 77%, 90% and even 100% of games...

Arsenal

- 100% of Arsenal home games have been Over 2.5 Goals, and 8 out of 9 games overall have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets.
- Arsenal have also won the Most Corners in all 4 home games, and in 89% of games overall.

Aston Villa

- An Aston Villa player has been shown the First Card in 78% of games so far (7 out of 9).
- Last season 74% of all Villa games went Over 10.5 Corners. That trend is continuing this season with 77% of games paying out on Over 10.5 Corners bets.

Birmingham

- Birmingham have got the First Card in 5 out of 5 away games so far.
- 70% of all Birmingham games have gone Under 3.5 Cards / Under 35.5 Booking Points.

Blackburn

- 'High goals' and 'low corners' bets have paid out in the majority of Blackburn games so far – 78% of games have gone Over 2.5 Goals and 78% have gone Under 10.5 Corners.
- Those 2 bets have paid out in all Blackburn's away games.

Bolton

- Bets on Over 10.5 Corners have paid out in 7 of Bolton's 9 games so far – 78%
- Bolton have only won the Most Corners in 1 game so far this season – and in none of their home games.

Burnley

- 80% of Burnley games (8 out of 10) have gone Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points.
- The average Total Booking Points per Burnley home game is 24 pts – the away figure is 26 pts (Eg. less than 3 yellow cards per Burnley game).

Chelsea

The league leaders have a stack of solid trends that you can cash-in on.

- Chelsea have won 8 of their first 10 games. And they have the best home Goal Difference – 15 Goals For and just 1 Goal Against, with 5 out of 5 wins at Stamford Bridge.
- 90% of Chelsea games have gone Over 10.5 Corners – their games are averaging 13.2 Total Corners.
- Chelsea have also won the Most Corners in 90% of games – and by a margin of at least 3 corners each time, covering a -2 Corner Handicap.
- 80% of Chelsea games have paid out on Over 2.5 Goals bets, with games averaging 3.2 Total Goals.

Everton

- Everton have been pretty well behaved so far – they have only got the Most Booking Points in 1 out of 9 games, and an Everton player has only got the

First Card on 2 occasions.

Fulham

- One of our 'top trends' last season was Fulham's 'low Bookings' record – 84% of games went Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points. The majority of Fulham games are also going Under this season – 67% .

Hull

- In 5 out of 5 away games so far, a Hull player has been shown the First Card.
- Bets on Over 10.5 Corners have paid out in 80% of Hull games so far – with games averaging 12.9 Total Corners.

Liverpool

- Liverpool have won the Most Corners in 80% of games so far – and in all 5 home games.
- A Liverpool player has only been shown the First Card in 1 of their 10 games. And the Reds have only got the Most Booking Points in 10% of games, too.

Man Utd

- Man Utd have won the Most Corners in 90% of all games.
- At Old Trafford, United have won the Most Corners in 5 out of 5 games. And on average they are winning over 9 corners more than their opponents – 11.6 Corners For and just 2 Corners Against at home.

Man City

- 89% of City games have gone Over 10.5 Corners – with an average of 12.9 Total Corners per game.
- Last season 73% of games at the City of Manchester Stadium went Over 10.5 Corners – so far in 2009/10 that bet has paid out in 4 out of 4 home games.

Portsmouth

- Portsmouth are bottom of the Premier League after 10 games – won 1, drawn 1 and lost 8. They have been beaten by a Winning Margin of exactly 1 goal in 6 of those 8 defeats, and in 5 out of 5 home games.
- 80% of Portsmouth games have paid out a winner on Over 10.5 Corners bets. Average Total Corners per game = 12.4.
- Bets on '0-1 Total Goals' have paid out in 60% of Pompey games. At odds of around 2/1 each time, that's an 80% Return on Investment.

Stoke

- A Stoke player has got the First Card in 100% of their away games so far – 5 out of 5.
- Stoke have only won the Most Corners in 1 out of 10 games – and they have yet to win the Most Corners in any of their games at the Britannia Stadium.
- Bets on Under 2.5 Goals have paid out in 70% of Stoke games – with games averaging 2.0 Total Goals.

Sunderland

- 80% of Sunderland games have paid out on bets on the Time of First Goal to be Before 27th Minute. The average First Goal Time in Sunderland games is just 17 minutes.
- Sunderland have only won the Most Corners in 1 out of 10 games so far – and they haven't won the Most Corners in any of their home games.

Tottenham

- Bets on Over 2.5 Goals have paid out on 90% of Spurs' games – with an average of 3.5 Total Goals per game.
- Spurs have only got the Most Booking Points in 1 game out of 10 so far.

West Ham

- 70% of West Ham games have been Over 10.5 Corners so far – with games averaging 11.8 Total Corners.

Wigan

- Wigan have only won the Most Corners once in 10 attempts. On average, they are conceding 2 corners per game more than they win. And they haven't won the most corners in any of their 5 games at the DW Stadium.

Wolves

- 80% of Wolves games have paid out on bets on the Time of First Goal to be Before 27th Minute.
- 80% of Wolves games have also gone Under 3.5 Cards and Under 35.5 Booking Points. With games averaging 23.5 Total Booking Points.
